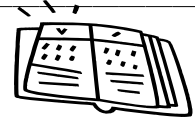

**Rebooking for Term 3****Invoicing Term 3**

To rebook your child's classes for Term 3 please forward your term 3 tuition payment to the office by **Saturday 26th June**.

To avoid disappointment please note that if we have not received your fees by this date we will assume that you no longer wish to hold a place in that class. Your place will then become available to others from Monday June 28th or in some cases if numbers are insufficient, the class may be cancelled.

A \$60 costume hire fee has been added to your child's invoice, if your child **is not** participating in the concert please deduct this amount from your child's fees. See page 3 for more information.

Fees for Toddler, Creative & Prep Dance Classes are refundable at any time during the term when the office is given two weeks notice, however the administration component of \$20 cannot be refunded.

Invoices are being handed out in week 7 of this Term (this gives 3 weeks until the due date). **This account is due by Saturday 26th June. If fees are paid by the due date you will receive a \$20 incentive discount per student. Any fees received after this date will not receive this discount.** If we have not received your fees by this date we will assume that you do not require us to hold your place in the class and will allocate it to the next person who requires the place. ## Ballet Examinations and Tests Requirements

For the Ballet, Jazz and Tap Exams and Tests the girls will need to have the following items:

- Leotard in the appropriate colour for their grade. Premier singlet top and pants for Jazz and Tap.
- Tan Jazz or Tan Tap Shoes. Clean Leather Ballet shoes (split soles are not allowed) with one elastic and the drawstring elastic around intact. To clean ballet shoes, you can either wipe the shoe down with a baby wipe or re-paint the shoe with shoe paint in the colour 'ballet', You can buy this from any shoe repair store. For the rethreading of the drawstring elastic and the shoe colour we recommend Shoe repair shop.
- Hair in a neat bun in the middle of the back of their head secured tightly with pins and a hair net matching the colour of the child's hair. To assist with the grooming of exams and tests, it is advised to keep hair as long as possible to be able to get hair back into a neat bun.
- Clean ballet tights for ballet students in perfect condition.
- For exams and tests, earrings are not allowed to be worn, If your child is planning on getting their ears pierced, please keep in mind they will have to take them out for their exam and test.
- Ballet shoes for the exam or test have to be fairly snug fitting and clean, so if your child is needing a new pair of shoes, it is advised you wait till after exams and tests, as if you get them now it won't allow your child enough time to wear them in properly.
